**Museum Board:**

This is the second Annual Report of the Board of Carlow County Museum. The Board consists of seven members, three Members of Carlow Town Council, three representatives of the Carlow Historical & Archaeological Society (CHAS) and a County Manager's nominee. The Curator of Carlow County Museum acts as Secretary to the Board.

The Board met on three occasions during 2008. The Chairperson is chosen from the three Members of the Town Council and the three CHAS representatives. As agreed the position of Chairperson alternates on an annual basis between the Members of the Town Council and the CHAS representatives. At the 2007 AGM Cllr. Rody Kelly was elected Chairperson.

**New Museum Premises:**

In February 2008 Carlow Town Council approved the plans for the new Museum premises. Tender documents are at an advanced stage. Pre tender investigation works are ongoing including the assessment of the structural integrity of the existing building and the method of construction for the extension. The investigation works identified that the first floor joists are in good condition but the timber beams located under the joists and the floor to ceiling columns located on the ground floor are giving little or no support to the joists due to poor foundations under the timber columns and sagging of the timber beams. As a result a number of gaps have appeared between the joists and beams & columns. A system of steel supports is currently being installed under the joists. Electrical, Plumbing & Heating Specialists have been engaged to draw up the lighting & heating specifications.

**Museum Board Visit to Clare:**

During February the Board undertook a site visit to Clare County Museum in Ennis. There were a number of similarities between this Museum and Carlow's new premises. The Museum is located in a former convent building, the Tourist Office acts as the Museum's reception area and their main display area is roughly the same size. They also have a temporary exhibition gallery.

**Royal Society of Antiquaries of Ireland (RSAI) Exhibition Launch**

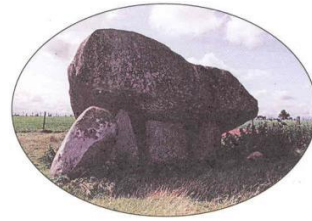
The Royal Society of Antiquaries (RSAI) launched their exhibition "Rubbing Shoulders with the Dead" in Dublin during September 2008. This exhibition received support from Carlow Local Authorities through Carlow County Museum and the Community & Enterprise Department.

To aid their fundraising and promote their profile the RSAI has decided to organise a series of exhibitions. The first of these exhibitions was based on the 19<sup>th</sup> century grave rubbings taken by members of Society including some by Carlow's Philip Doyne Vigors. These rubbings show the detail of either headstones or burial tombs. One of the most interesting of these rubbings is that taken at St Mullins. Included in this particular rubbing are rare images of five Irish saints, St Mullins, St Patrick, St Brigid, St Columcille and St James.

Due to the rarity and quality of the five Irish Saints the RSAI decided to reproduce them as a series of greeting cards with the support of Carlow Local Authorities. The opening of the exhibition was attended by members of the Board along with Cllr. Tom O'Neill, Cathaoirleach of Carlow Town Council.

### **Bord an Mhúsaem:**

Is í seo an dara Tuarascáil Bhliantúil de chuid Bhord Mhúsaem Contae Cheatharlach. Seachtar comhaltaí atá ar an mBord, triúr atá ina gComhaltaí ar Chomhairle Baile Cheatharlach, triúr ionadaithe thar ceann Chumann Staire agus Seandálaíochta Cheatharlach (CSSC) agus duine amháin atá ainmnithe ag an mBainisteoir Contae. Is é Coimeádaí Mhúsaem Contae Cheatharlach atá ag gníomhú mar Rúnaí ar an mBord.

Tháinig an Board le chéile trí huair sa bhliain 2008. Roghnaítear an Cathaoirleach as triúr Comhaltaí na Comhairle Baile agus triúr ionadaithe an CSSC. Mar atá socraithe, déantar uainíocht go bliantúil ar phost an Chathaoirligh is é sin idir Chomhaltaí na Comhairle Baile agus ionadaithe CSSC. Toghadh an Clr. Rody Kelly ina Chathaoirleach ag CCB 2007.

### **Foirgneamh an Mhúsaem Nua:**

Cheadaigh Comhairle Baile Cheatharlach na pleananna don fhoirgneamh don Mhúsaem nua i mí Feabhra 2008. Tá dul chun cinn mór déanta maidir leis na doiciméid tairisceana. Tá oibreacha cigireachta réamhthairisceana ar siúl lena n-áirítear measúnú ar a shláine is atá déanamhas an fhoirgnimh atá ann agus an modh foirgníochta don mhéadú. Fuarthas amach de bharr na n-oibreacha cigireachta go bhfuil giarsaí an chéad urláir i gcaoi mhaith ach nach bhfuil mórán tacaíochta nó aon tacaíocht ag na giarsaí ó na bíomaí adhmaid atá faoi na giarsaí ná ó na colúin, ón urlár go dtí an tsíleáil, atá ar an mbunurlár mar go bhfuil na bunsraitheanna atá faoi na colúin adhmaid i ndroch-chaoi agus mar go bhfuil na bíomaí adhmaid ag lúbadh. Dá bharr sin tá poill idir na giarsaí agus na bíomaí agus na colúin. Tá tacaí cruach á bhfeistiú faoi na giarsaí faoi láthair. Táthar tar éis Speisialtóirí Leictreachais, Pluiméireachta agus Téimh a fhostú chun na sonraíochtaí don soilsiú agus don téamh a leagan amach.

### **Bord an Mhúsaem ar Cuairt ar Cho. an Chláir:**

Thug an Bord cuairt ar Mhúsaem Contae an Chláir in Inis i mí Feabhra. Tarlaíonn sé go bhfuil roinnt cosúlachtaí idir an Músaem seo agus foirgneamh nua Cheatharlach. Tá an Músaem suite i bhfoirgneamh a bhí ina chlochar tráth, is í an Oifig Turasóireachta an áit fáiltithe don Mhúsaem agus is beagnach gurb é an spás céanna atá sa phríomhát taiseántais. Tá gailearaí acu le haghaidh taiseántais shealadacha freisin.

### **Taispeántas Chumann Ríoga Ársaíochta na hÉireann (CRÁÉ) á Sheoladh**

Sheol Cumann Ríoga Ársaíochta na hÉireann (CRÁÉ) an taispeántas dá chuid, *“Rubbing Shoulders with the Dead”*, i mBaile Átha Cliath i mí Mheán Fómhair, 2008. Fuair an taispeántas seo tacaíocht ó Údarás Áitiúla Cheatharlach trí Mhúsaem Contae Cheatharlach agus tríd an Rannóg Pobail agus Fiontar.

Tá sé beartaithe ag CRÁÉ sraith taispeántas a eagrú ar mhaithe lena bhfeachtas bailithe airgid agus le tuilleadh eolais a scaipeadh faoin gcumann. Bunaíodh an chéad cheann de na taispeántais seo ar na cuimilteáin d'íomhánna ón 19ú céad atá ar leaca uaighe i gCeatharlach a rinne baill den Chumann lena n-áirítear roinnt a rinne Philip Doyne Vigors de bhunadh Cheatharlach. Taispeántar íomhánna atá ar leaca uaighe nó ar leaca tuama ar na cuimilteáin seo. Tá an ceann a rinneadh i dTigh Moling ar cheann de na cuimilteáin is spéisiúla díobh sin. Tá íomhánna nach bhfeictear ach go hannamh de chúigear naomh Éireannach ar an gcuimilteán áirithe seo - Moling, Pádraig, Bríd, Colm Cille agus Séamas.

De bhrí nach minic a fheictear íomhánna den chúigear naomh Éireannach úd agus de bhrí go bhfuil caighdeán na gcuimilteán chomh maith sin bheartaigh CRÁÉ iad a atáirgeadh ina sraith de chártaí beannachta le tacaíocht ó Údaráis Áitiúla Cheatharlach. Bhí comhaltaí Boird chomh maith leis an gClr. Tom O'Neill, Cathaoirleach Chomhairle Baile Cheatharlach i láthair nuair a seoladh an taispeántas.
